## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 269460 ADOPTED ON OCT 12 1987

WHEREAS, the Second Harbor Entrance Project (SHEP) is about two years old and it was initially funded by the cities of Chula Vista and National City; and

WHEREAS, its primary goal then was public education in order to determine the level of support for a second San Diego Bay entrance channel; and

WHEREAS, SHEP has recently been incorporated as a nonprofit corporation, and is currently awaiting certification of 501C status and it is requesting \$50,000 from the City towards its Fiscal Year 1987-88 budget of \$300,000; and

WHEREAS, the funds are required primarily to support preliminary engineering and environmental studies; and

WHEREAS, in the late 1960s and early 1970s, the United States Army Corps of Engineers performed studies that identified two potential locations for a second channel, and found that such a channel would have a favorable effect on flushing action in the Bay, and SHEP's proposed studies would analyze data from these earlier Corps of Engineers' studies as a staring point; and

WHEREAS, a second channel would be very beneficial to recreational boaters and associated businesses, especially in the South Bay and would also improve water quality in the Bay as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the City Manger has provided the necessary information in his September 8, 1987 Report No. 87-473 to the Public Facilities and Recreation Committee (PF&R Committee) and recommends that the requested funds be allocated for the recited purpose; and

WHEREAS, the PF&R Committee approved the City Manager's recommendation on September 9, 1987 by a 5-0 vote and has forwarded the matter to the full Council for appropriate action; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that that the City Manager be and he is hereby fully authorized and empowered to execute a Letter Agreement with SECOND HARBOR ENTRANCE PROJECT, INC. (SHEP), a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-269460, for the purpose of conducting engineering and environmental studies of a second channel entrance to San Diego Bay, said Letter Agreement to be effective upon execution thereof through June 30, 1988, for a contractual sum not to exceed \$50,000.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized to transfer within the General Fund 100 the sum of \$50,000 from the Unallocated Reserve (605) to the Allocated Reserve (901) for the above purpose and to be expended

by the City Manager pursuant to the terms of the Letter Agreement recited above.
