ADOPTED ON OCT 13 1987

WHEREAS, the City Council has committed itself to end hunger in San Diego; and

WHEREAS, Church World Service, in concert with ministerial associations and interfaith groups throughout San Diego County, is sponsoring "Walks for the Hungry" on Sunday, October 18, in seven locations throughout the County, including Chula Vista, Escondido, La Jolla, Oceanside, Ramona, Navajo/East County and Encinitas; and

WHEREAS, proceeds from these walks will be used by Church World Service for hunger relief projects throughout the world and for ten designated local community agencies involved in feeding the hungry; and

WHEREAS, the local beneficiaries of the seven walks being held in the region are Project Hand in Chula Vista, the North County Interfaith Crisis Center in Escondido, the Ecumenical Service Center in Oceanside, the Ramona Food and Clothes Closet, Crisis House in El Cajon, the Heartland Human Relations Association in La Mesa, the Community Resource Center in Encinitas, the North County Chaplaincy and the San Diego Hunger Coalition; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of The City of San Diego, that Sunday, October 18, 1987, be declared "Walk for the Hungry Day" in The City of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Church World Service, the Navajo Interfaith Association, the North County Interfaith Council, the Oceanside/Carlsbad Ministerial Association, the Ramona Ministerial Association, the Southbay Ecumenical Council, the San Dieguito Ministerial Association, the San Diego Hunger Coalition and the Bishop's School are hereby commended for their timeless efforts to end hunger and to reduce the suffering of millions of our fellow human beings.
