A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE SALE OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY IN THE MOUNT HOPE REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA TO GATEWAY MEDICAL CENTER, LTD.; APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDED DISPOSITION AND DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT PERTAINING THERETO; AND MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS WITH RESPECT TO SUCH SALE.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Mount Hope Redevelopment Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out and implement such
Redevelopment Plan the Agency has negotiated a proposed First
Amended Disposition and Development Agreement (the "First Amended
Agreement") with Gateway Medical Center, Ltd., (the "Developer")
for the sale of real property in the Project area for the
development and construction of a medical/professional office
building of about 40,000 square feet and the Agency proposes to
enter into the First Amended Agreement with the Developer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the First Amended Agreement the Agency proposes to sell certain property as described in the First Amended Agreement in the Project area to the Developer for the construction thereon of the facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Developer has executed and submitted to the Agency and the Council of The City of San Diego (the "Council")

copies of said proposed First Amended Agreement in a form desired by the Developer; and

WHEREAS, the Southeast Economic Development Corporation,
Inc., has reviewed and discussed said proposed First Amended
Agreement and has recommended that the Council approve and the
Agency enter into the First Amended Agreement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the California Community Redevelopment
Law (California Health and Safety Code, Section 33000 et seq.),
the Agency and the Council held a joint public hearing on the
proposed sale of such real property pursuant to such First
Amended Agreement; having duly published notice of such public
hearing and made copies of the proposed First Amended Agreement,
and other reports and documents available for public inspection
and comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council has duly considered all terms and conditions of the proposed sale of real property and believes that the redevelopment of the real property pursuant to the proposed First Amended Agreement is in the best interests of the City and health, safety, morals and welfare of its residents, and in accord with the public purposes and provisions of applicable State and local law and requirements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Council recognizes that it has received and heard all oral and written objections to the proposed First Amended Agreement, to the proposed sale of the real property pursuant to the proposed First Amended Agreement, and to other matters

pertaining to this transaction, and that all such oral and written objections are hereby overruled.

- 2. The Council hereby finds and determines that the consideration to be paid by the Developer for the purchase of the real property upon which the medical/professional office building of about 40,000 square feet is to be developed and constructed is not less than fair market value in accordance with the covenants and conditions governing such purchase as set forth in the First Amended Agreement. The Council hereby further finds and determines that all consideration to be paid under the First Amended Agreement is in amounts necessary to effectuate the purposes of the Redevelopment Plan for the Project.
- 3. The sale of the real property, and the First Amended Agreement which establishes the terms and conditions for the sale and development of the real property, are hereby approved.
- 4. The Council hereby authorizes the City Clerk to deliver a copy of this resolution to the Executive Director and members of the Agency. A copy of the First Amended Agreement when executed by the Agency shall be placed on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-269482.
