VACATION OF TWELFTH AVENUE SOUTH OF IMPERIAL AVENUE.

WHEREAS, it is proposed that Twelfth Avenue South of Imperial Avenue be vacated; and

WHEREAS, there is no present or prospective use for Twelfth Avenue South of Imperial Avenue either for the public street system for which the right-of-way was originally acquired or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated in that the right-of-way is not needed for public street, bikeway, or open space purposes; and

WHEREAS, the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and

WHEREAS, the vacation or abandonment is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that the vacation be conditioned upon completion of consolidation parcel map and specified public improvements for the affected parcels being approved by Council action; and

WHEREAS, the public street system for which the right-of-way was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by this vacation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, California, as follows:

- 2. That Twelfth Avenue south of Imperial Avenue, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 17102-B, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-269408, which said Drawing is attached hereto and made a part hereof, be, and the same is hereby ordered vacated.
- 3. That the resolution shall not become effective unless and until the following conditions have been met:
- a. A consolidation parcel map for the affected parcels must be approved and recorded in the Office of the County Recorder.
- b. Issuance of permits and bonding for construction of the public improvements to include curb, gutter and sidewalk construction across the vacated area adjacent to Imperial Avenue, satisfactory to the City Engineer.
- 4. In the event that the above items are not completed within two (2) years after adoption, this resolution shall become void and be of no further force or effect.
- 5. That the City Engineer shall advise the City Clerk of the approval of the aforementioned subdivision map, and required public improvements, and that the City Clerk shall then cause a certified copy of this resolution, attested by him under seal, with drawings, to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder.




