WHEREAS, on December 8, 1987, the Council of The City of San Diego ("Council") considered the Interim Development Ordinance ("IDO") Non-Accelerated Variance Application No. 87-2151, by S. L. Emerson, Inc., Planning Report No. 87-627, to construct fifteen (15) new units at 6025-41 Estelle Street, zoned MR-1000 (44 du/ac). The site is approximately eighteen thousand seven hundred fifty (18,750) square feet. An eighteen (18) unit multi-family condominium project would take the place of three (3) single-family dwelling units. Street accessed parking garages will be provided; exterior - whole wheat stucco; roof - red Spanish tile, in the Mid-City Community; and

WHEREAS, the request for Non-Accelerated Variance submitted by S. L. Emerson, Inc., pursuant to the IDO Section 7.C.3.; and

WHEREAS, the request for Non-Accelerated Variance submitted is governed by IDO Section 7.C.4., pursuant to which units granted will be taken from the reserve allocation as set forth in Schedule A of the IDO as modified by the procedures set forth in Resolution No. R-269742 adopted by the Council on November 16, 1987; and

WHEREAS, in arriving at their decision, the Council considered the staff report, the decision of the IDO Administrator, reviewed the plans and materials submitted prior to and at the public hearing, and heard public testimony presented at the hearing; NOW, THEREFORE,

- 1. Reserve allocation for units in the community is depleted for the year.
- 2. Facilities adjustment factor for the community does not reach the acceptable level.
- 3. The project does not comply with the Mid-City Community Planned District Ordinance.
- 4. The project would exceed the IDO cap, requiring units to be borrowed from other communities.
- 5. The service level in the area of the project is at Level F and congestion would be increased as a result of the project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the decision of the Council shall be final.
