

ORDINANCE NUMBER 0- 16998 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON DEC 8 1987

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-16916 (NEW SERIES), ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1987-1988 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" IS HEREBY AMENDED TO INCREASE THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM BY ADDING \$1,657,234 TO CIP NO. 22-024.1 SOUTH SHORES DEVELOPMENT, PHASE I, FROM ANTICIPATED REVENUES TO BE DERIVED FROM SENATE BILL 174 (ROBERTI-Z'BERG) \$670,294, PROPOSITION 1 \$356,940, AND CALIFORNIA BOATING AND WATERWAYS BILL \$630,000.


BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 0-16916 (New Series), as amended, entitled "An Ordinance Adopting the Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year 1987-1988 and Appropriating the Necessary Money to Operate the City for Said Fiscal Year" is hereby amended to increase the Capital Improvements Program by adding \$1,657,234 to CIP No. 22-024.1 SOUTH SHORES DEVELOPMENT, PHASE I, from anticipated revenues to be derived from Senate Bill 174 (Roberti-Z'berg) \$670,294, Proposition 1 \$356,940, and California Boating and Waterways Bill \$630,000.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two (2) public hearings, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.
