AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2,  
DIVISION 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY  
AMENDING SECTION 22.0101, ENTITLED "PERMANENT  
RULES OF THE COUNCIL" BY AMENDING RULE 18  
RELATING TO THE "COMMITTEE ON RULES,  
LEGISLATION AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS."

WHEREAS, it has been requested that Rule 18 of the Permanent Rules of Council be amended to permit, under specified circumstances, the composition of the Rules Committee to include the chairperson of the Housing Commission; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 2, Division 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 22.0101, Rule 18 to read as follows:

RULE 18. Committee on Rules, Legislation and  
Intergovernmental Relations


There is a Committee on Rules, Legislation and Intergovernmental Relations (herein referred to as "Rules Committee") composed of five (5) voting members consisting of the Mayor, the Deputy Mayor and the three (3) chairpersons of the other standing committees. In the event, however, that the Deputy Mayor is also a chairperson of a standing committee, the composition shall be the Mayor, Deputy Mayor, two (2) chairpersons of standing committees and the Councilmember appointed as chairperson of the Housing

Commission. The Mayor shall be permanent chairperson and the Deputy Mayor shall be vice-chairperson of the Rules Committee.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

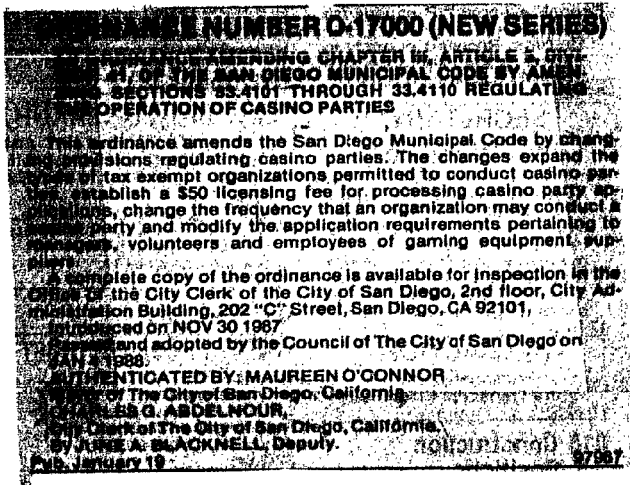


