AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V, ARTICLE 6, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 56.54 RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONSUMPTION AND POSSESSION PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN AREAS.

Section 1. That Chapter V, Article 6, section 56.54 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 56.54 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONSUMPTION AND POSSESSION PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN AREAS

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person without a permit duly issued by the City Manager for a special event to consume any alcoholic beverage, as defined in California Business and Professions Code, section 23004, upon any public street, sidewalk, alley, plaza, or in any public park within the following limits of the City of San Diego:

Starting at the intersection of Market
Street and Pacific Highway and proceeding
northerly on Pacific Highway to its
intersection with Ash Street; then easterly on
Ash Street to its intersection with the
easterly boundary of 11th Avenue; then
southerly along the easterly boundary of 11th

Avenue to the northerly boundary of Russ
Boulevard; then easterly along the northerly
boundary of Russ Boulevard to the easterly
boundary of Interstate Highway 5; then
southerly on the easterly boundary of
Interstate Highway 5 to its intersection with
Imperial Avenue; then westerly on Imperial
Avenue to Harbor Drive; then northwesterly on
Harbor Drive to Pacific Highway; and then
northerly along Pacific Highway to the point
of beginning.

The area described above shall include all sidewalks along the outer perimeter of such areas.

The provisions of this section shall not apply to persons consuming alcoholic beverages within the defined boundaries of a sidewalk cafe located on the public right-of-way. A sidewalk cafe is defined in Section 101.0550.

- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person without a permit duly issued by the City Manager for a special event to consume or to possess an open container of any alcoholic beverage, as defined in Business and Professions Code section 23004, in the following areas of The City of San Diego:
- (1) The "beach area" starting at Ratkay Point and proceeding northerly along the waterfront of

the Pacific Ocean and waters of Mission Bay to the northerly boundry of the Mission Bay channel entrance between the hours from twelve o'clock midnight and six o'clock a.m. and the "beach area" starting at the northerly boundry of the Mission Bay channel entrance and proceeding northerly along the waterfront of the Pacific Ocean and waters of Mission Bay to the southerly limits of the City of Del Mar between the hours from ten o'clock p.m. and six o'clock a.m.

"Beach area" means any beach or land and the waters abutting or adjacent thereto within the limits of The City of San Diego and of all lands owned or controlled by the City adjoining the waterfront of the Pacific Ocean and the waters of Mission Bay.

"Beach area" includes the Ocean Beach Fishing
Pier, Torrey Pines State Beach and any public area,
boardwalk and public right-of-way such as exists
along Ocean Front Walk extending up to the
boundaries of adjacent property owners including
fences and walls maintained under Encroachment
Removal Agreements.

(2) Fiesta Island and all public beaches and public recreation areas within Mission Bay Park between the hours from ten o'clock p.m. and six o'clock a.m.;

- (3) all public parking lots within Mission Bay Park.
- (4) the West parking lot of the Jetty at 600 Block San Diego Place;
- (5) the parking areas around The Plunge and Belmont Park Roller Coaster at 3000 to 3200 Block Ocean Front Walk, 3000 to 3200 Block Mission Boulevard and 700 Block Ventura Place;
 - (6) the La Jolla Shores parking lot at 8300 Block Camino del Oro;
- (7) the 600 Block Tourmaline Street.
 The public parking lots at the following locations:
 - (8) The 2400 Block Bacon Street, including the area commonly known as Robb Field;
 - (9) the 5200 Block Voltaire Street;
 - (10) the 5200 Block Brighton Street;
 - (11) the 5000 Block Newport Avenue, including the parking area at the foot of Newport Avenue;
 - (12) the 1900 Block Abbott Street;
 - (13) the 1100 to 1300 Block Sunset Cliffs Boulevard;
 - (14) the 4400 Block Ladera Street;
 - (15) the 2400 to 2500 Block Sunset Cliffs Boulevard.

The area described above shall include all sidewalks along the outer perimeter of such areas.

(c) This section does not make punishable any act or acts which are prohibited by any law of the State of California.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

OLD LANGUAGE - STRIKEOUT NEW LANGUAGE - UNDERLINED

SEC. 56.54 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONSUMPTION AND POSSESSION PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN AREAS

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person without a permit duly issued by the City Manager for a special event to consume any alcoholic beverage, as defined in California Business and Professions Code, section 23004, upon any public street, sidewalk, alley, plaza, or in any public park within the following limits of the City of San Diego:

Starting at the intersection of Mattin

Luthet King/ It/ Way Afothetly Market Streety
and Pacific Highway and proceeding northerly
on Pacific Highway to its intersection with
Ash Street; then easterly on Ash Street to its
intersection with the easterly boundary of
11th Avenue; then southerly along the easterly
boundary of 11th Avenue to the northerly
boundary of Russ Boulevard; then easterly
along the northerly boundary of Russ Boulevard
to the easterly boundary of Interstate Highway
5; then southerly on the easterly boundary of
Interstate Highway 5 to its intersection with

Imperial Avenue; then westerly on Imperial Avenue to Harbor Drive; then northwesterly on Harbor Drive to Pacific Highway; and then northerly along Pacific Highway to the point of beginning.

The area described above shall include all sidewalks along the outer perimeter of such areas.

The provisions of this section shall not apply to persons consuming alcoholic beverages within the defined boundaries of a sidewalk cafe located on the public right-of-way. A sidewalk cafe is defined in Section 101.0550.

- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person without a permit duly issued by the City Manager for a special event to consume or to possess an open container of any alcoholic beverage, as defined in Business and Professions Code section 23004, in the following areas of The City of San Diego:

- (3) (5) the parking areas around The Plunge and Belmont Park Roller Coaster at 3000 to

Block Mission Boulevard and 700 Block Ventura Place;

(4) (6) the La Jolla Shores parking lot at 8300 Block Camino del Oro;

The public parking lots at the following locations:

(8) (8) The 2400 Block Bacon Street, including the area commonly known as Robb Field;

(7) (9) the 5200 Block Voltaire Street;

(8) (10) the 5200 Block Brighton Street;

(9) (11) the 5000 Block Newport Avenue, including the parking area at the foot of Newport Avenue;

(10) (12) the 1900 Block Abbott Street;

(11) (13) the 1100 to 1300 Block Sunset Cliffs Boulevard;

(12) (14) the 4400 Block Ladera Street;

(13) (15) the 2400 to 2500 Block Sunset Cliffs Boulevard.

The area described above shall include all sidewalks along the outer perimeter of such areas.

(c) This section does not make punishable any act or acts which are prohibited by any law of the State of California.
