AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2,  
DIVISION 2, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY  
AMENDING SECTION 22.0226 RELATING TO THE  
HIRING OF CONSULTANTS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 2, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 22.0226 to read as follows:

**SEC. 22.0226 CONSULTANT LIMITATIONS**

A. In connection with the provisions of Section 28 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, the City Manager, except as otherwise provided by Charter or ordinance, shall have the power to employ experts or consultants to perform work or give advice connected with departments of the City without first seeking Council approval under the following conditions:


1. For architectural or engineering consultants who are retained to design City Council approved individual capital improvement projects, the cost of such employment does not exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00).

2. For all other consultants when the cost of such employment does not exceed Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00).

B. However, if the total compensation paid to an expert or consultant exceeds One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) during any twelve (12) month period, Council approval must be obtained.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

A. In connection with the provisions of Section 28 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, the City Manager, except as otherwise provided by Charter or ordinance, shall have the power to employ experts or consultants to perform work or give advice connected with departments of the City without first seeking Council approval ~~provided the cost of such employment does not exceed ten thousand dollars~~ ~~(\$10,000)~~ under the following conditions:

1. For architectural or engineering consultants who are retained to design City Council approved individual capital improvement projects, the cost of such employment does not exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00).

2. For all other consultants when the cost of such employment does not exceed Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00).

B. However, if the total compensation paid to an expert or consultant exceeds ~~\$10,000~~ One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) during a any twelve (12) month period, Council approval must be obtained.

This Ordinance amends SEC. 22.0226 to provide two (2) types of consultant contracting limitations. As amended, the Manager should be able to retain design consultants for approved Capital Improvement Projects at amounts up to One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00). For all other consultant contracts the Manager's signature limit would be raised from Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) to Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00).
