AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-16916 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1987-88 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. 00-16916-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY TRANSFERRING THE AMOUNT OF \$182,575 FROM THE INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT REVENUE BOND ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE FUND TO THE MID-CITY FACADE IMPROVEMENT REBATE PROGRAM (IN THE AMOUNT OF \$88,575) AND THE OCEAN BEACH COMMERCIAL REVITALIZATION REBATE PROGRAM (IN THE AMOUNT OF \$94,000); TRANSFERRING THE AMOUNT OF \$88,575 FROM THE MID-CITY FACADE IMPROVEMENT REBATE PROGRAM TO THE ENTERPRISE ZONE DEVELOPER FEE REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM; TRANSFERRING THE AMOUNT OF \$94,000 FROM THE OCEAN BEACH COMMERCIAL REVITALIZATION REBATE PROGRAM TO THE ENTERPRISE ZONE DEVELOPER FEE REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS SO ALLOCATED.

WHEREAS, in previous actions, the City Council has allocated 1987 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds for the Mid-City Facade Improvement Rebate Program and the Ocean Beach Commercial Revitalization Rebate Program; and

WHEREAS, both of these programs contain provisions for reimbursing business or property owners for certain costs involved in improving or developing their property; and

WHEREAS, for the 1984 CDBG allocation for the Mid-City Facade Improvement Rebate Program, the City had encountered difficulties in finding property owners and merchants willing to take

advantage of the Program because of the administrative burdens which imposed increased costs on projects which in many cases exceeded the value of the incentives, and which therefore prompted the City in Ordinance No. O-16784 (New Series) to utilize sales tax revenue in place of CDBG funds; and

WHEREAS, the fee reimbursements which are a part of the City's Enterprise Zone incentives were affected by these same administrative requirements, which therefore prompted the City in Ordinance No. O-16872 (New Series) to utilize the Industrial Development Revenue Bond Administrative Expense Fund in the place of the CDBG funds originally allocated for fee reimbursements; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice in August, 1987, issued new regulations pertaining to the administrative requirements for the use of CDBG funds, and those regulations no longer restrict the use of CDBG funds for the Enterprise Zone fee reimbursements, but continue to apply to the Mid-City and Ocean Beach Rebate Programs; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance would withdraw use of CDBG funds for the Mid-City and Ocean Beach Rebate Programs and instead place those funds into the Enterprise Zone Developer Fee Reimbursement Program, resulting in no net reduction in the use of CDBG money for CDBG projects; and

WHEREAS, the City will use its Industrial Development Revenue
Bond Administrative Expense Fund to accomplish the Mid-City
Facade Improvement and Ocean Beach Commercial Revitalization
Rebate Programs; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16916 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1987-88 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-16916-1, as amended and adopted therein, as follows:

- 1. By transferring \$182,575 from the Industrial
 Development Revenue Bond Administrative Expense Fund,
 previously allocated to the Enterprise Zone for developer fee
 reimbursements (Fund 10240), and allocating \$88,575 of that
 amount to the Mid-City Facade Improvement Rebate Program
 (non-personnel expense) and the remaining \$94,000 of that
 amount to the Ocean Beach Commercial Revitalization Rebate
 Program (non-personnel expense);
- 2. By transferring \$88,575 of the Mid-City Facade Improvement Rebate Program (Fund 18522, Dept. 5865, Org. 6503) to the Enterprise Zone Program (non-personnel expense); and
- 3. By transferring \$94,000 from the Ocean Beach Commercial Revitalization Rebate Program (Fund 18523, Dept. 5633, Org. 311) to the Enterprise Zone Program (non-personnel expense).

Section 2. The transfers of funds described in Section 1. herein are hereby authorized and approved, and the expenditure of

such funds for the purposes described herein are also authorized and approved.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two (2) public hearings, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.
