AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 4, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING SECTION 101.0462 RELATING TO INTERIM RESOURCE PROTECTION OVERLAY ZONE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 4, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 101.0462, to read as follows:

SEC. 101.0462 INTERIM RESOURCE PROTECTION OVERLAY ZONE

- B. APPLICATION OF THE RESOURCE PROTECTION OVERLAY
 ZONE

The Resource Protection Overlay Zone shall be applied to all property located within the boundaries of the following referenced areas:

1. All floodways and one hundred (100) year floodplain fringe areas as identified in the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) maps on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-16939-1, all areas within the City's existing Floodway (FW) or Floodplain Fringe (FPF) Zones, and all floodways and one hundred (100) year

floodplain fringe areas as identified in the County of San Diego FEMA map panel Nos. 1350, 1363, 1636, as modified, and No. 1650 on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-17087.

- 2. All hillside areas of twenty-five percent (25%) slope or greater as identified by the City's existing Hillside Review Overlay Zone (HR).
- 3. All wetland and wetland buffer areas in Map Drawings C-713 and C-740 on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document Nos. 00-16939-2 and 00-16939-3.

Where any portion of a parcel is located within the Resource Protection Overlay Zone, the regulations of the Resource Protection Overlay Zone shall be applicable to the entire parcel.
