BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:


Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16916 (New Series), as amended entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1987-88 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. O-16916-1, as adopted and amended therein, by deleting one (1.00) Accountant II position and by adding one (1.00) Principal Accountant position to the personnel authorization schedule of the City Treasurer, Department 052.

Section 2. That the position added in section 1 above be and the same is hereby exempted from the classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service of The City of San Diego, after favorable comment by the Civil Service Commission at its April 7, 1988 meeting.

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the above unclassified position, the salary rate set forth in Salary Rate 07.3, 07.4 and 07.5 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Managerial Category A, contained in Exhibit C to Ordinance No. O-16867 (New Series), be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage after two (2) public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.
