AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-16867 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR FISCAL YEAR 1987-88" BY CREATING A NEW CLASSIFICATION IN THE EXECUTIVE CATEGORY OF THE UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE IN CLASSIFICATION RANGE III, SALARY RANGE 03.0, 03.1 AND 03.2

WHEREAS, the Mayor has proposed that a class of City Architect be established and placed within the Planning Department; and

WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the Rules Committee on April 6, 1988 and approved in concept unanimously with a recommendation that it be forwarded to the full Council for action which requires an amendment to the salary ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Rules Committee Consultant Analysis 88-5 was presented to the Rules Committee on April 6, 1988, setting forth an in depth analysis of the proposal and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the matter is now presented to the full Council for final action thereon; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16867 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1987-88" be and the same is hereby amended by


amending Exhibit C thereto to create and include therein a new classification entitled "CITY ARCHITECT."

Section 2. That the above newly created class of City Architect be placed in the executive category of the unclassified service in classification range III, salary range 03.0, 03.1 and 03.2.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
