AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 16867 NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1987-88" TO CREATE THE NEW POSITION OF COMMITTEE CONSULTANTS' SECRETARY; EXEMPTING THE POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AMENDING EXHIBIT C TO SAID ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE SAID POSITION; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, it has been requested that a class entitled "Committee Consultants' Secretary" be established in the unclassified service by memo from the Deputy Mayor dated March 14, 1988, said position to replace one (1.00) currently authorized Council Secretary; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission reviewed the justification for the position on April 7, 1988 and has commented unfavorably; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the annual salary ordinance to create said position if Council should deem it appropriate and establish an appropriate rate of compensation therefrom; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:


Section 1. That Ordinance No. 16867 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO

FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1987-88" be and the same is hereby further amended by creating and establishing the position of Committee Consultants' Secretary.

Section 2. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon unfavorably by the Civil Service Commission on April 7, 1988 as not meeting the Charter criterion for exemption from the classified service, and after having considered and reviewed the report thereon from the Civil Service Commission, attached hereto as Attachment A, the Council deems exemption appropriate and the position created in section 1 above be and the same is hereby exempted from the classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service of The City of San Diego.

Section 3. That said Ordinance No. 16867 (New Series) be and it is hereby further amended to amend Exhibit C thereto so as to reflect said position designation of Council Consultant Secretary in Managerial Category A.

Section 4. As a schedule of compensation for the position established and enumerated in sections 1 and 2 above, the position of Committee Consultant Secretary is hereby authorized at salary ranges of 07.0, 07.1 and 07.2.



Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

SUBJECT: UNCLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES - CHARTER SECTION 117

On April 7, 1988, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Deputy Mayor's Office to exempt a "Committee Consultants Secretary" position in Councilmanic Administration from the Classified Service. This position is currently classified as a Council Secretary.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "Managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council."

Upon review of the duties and responsibilities assigned to this position, the Commission finds that it does not have significant responsibility for formulating or administering departmental policies or programs. Rather, the duties as outlined, are consistent with those regularly performed by other secretarial positions within the Classified Service. Therefore, the Commission recommends against exempting this position from the Classified Service as it does not comply with the requirements of the Charter.

If additional information would be of assistance, staff is available to respond with details as necessary.
