AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1,  
DIVISION 11.5, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE  
BY ADDING SECTION 101.1152.1 RELATING TO  
ADVERTISING DISPLAYS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as  
follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 11.5, of the  
San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by  
adding Section 101.1152.1, to read as follows:

SEC. 101.1152.1 REMOVAL OF ADVERTISING DISPLAYS IN  
RESIDENTIAL ZONES

In accordance with Section 5412.1 of the California  
Business and Professions Code, those advertising  
displays meeting all or the following requirements shall  
be removed without compensation:

A. The display is located within an area  
shown as residential in an adopted community plan,  
or on the map of the Progress Guide and General  
Plan.

B. The display is located within an area  
zoned for residential use.

C. The display is not located within six  
hundred sixty (660) feet from the edge of the  
right-of-way of an interstate or primary highway  
with its copy visible from the highway, nor is


placed or maintained beyond six hundred sixty (660) feet from the edge of the right-of-way of an interstate or primary highway with the purpose of its message being read from the main traveled way.

D. The display is not required to be removed because of an overlay zone, combining zone, or any other special zoning district whose primary purpose is the removal or control of signs.

E. The display is allowed to remain in existence for a period of seven (7) years after the enactment of this section or the date upon which it becomes applicable to the display, and after giving notice of the removal requirement to the display owner and the owner of the underlying property.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 11.5, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by adding Section 101.1152.1, to read as follows:

**SEC. 101.1152.1 REMOVAL OF ADVERTISING DISPLAYS IN RESIDENTIAL ZONES**

In accordance with Section 5412.1 of the California Business and Professions Code, those advertising displays meeting all of the following requirements shall be removed with compensation:

A. The display is located within an area shown as residential in an adopted community plan, or on the map of the Progress Guide and General Plan.

B. The display is located within an area zoned for residential use.

C. The display is not located within six hundred sixty (660) feet from the edge of the right-of-way of an interstate or primary highway with its copy visible from the highway, nor is placed or maintained beyond six hundred sixty (660) feet from the edge of the right-of-way of an interstate or primary highway with the purpose of its message being read from the main traveled way.

D. The display is not required to be removed because of an overlay zone, combining zone, or any other special zoning district whose primary purpose is the removal or control of signs.

E. The display is allowed to remain in existence for a period of seven (7) years after the enactment of this section or the date upon which it becomes applicable to the display, and after giving notice of the removal requirement to the display owner and the owner of the underlying property.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
