AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 7, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING SECTION 27.2523 AND BY AMENDING SECTIONS 27.2501, 27.2525 AND 27.2531 RELATING TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS, WITHOUT A QUALIFYING PETITION, A PROPOSITION FOR THE REPEAL, AMENDMENT OR ENACTMENT OF ANY LEGISLATIVE ACT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 7, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by adding section 27.2523 to read as follows:

SEC. 27.2523 DIRECT SUBMISSION OF LEGISLATIVE ACT TO VOTERS WITHOUT PETITION

The City Council may submit to the voters of
The City of San Diego, without a petition therefor,
a proposition for the repeal, amendment or
enactment of any legislative act, to be voted upon
at any succeeding regular or special municipal
election, and if the proposition submitted receives
a majority of the votes cast on it at the election,
the legislative act shall be repealed, amended or
enacted accordingly. A special or general election
may be called for the purpose of voting on the
matter.

Section 2. That Chapter II, Article 7, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending sections 27.2501, 27.2525 and 27.2531 to read as follows:

SEC. 27.2501 SUBJECTS OF INITIATIVE

Any proposed legislative act or proposed amendment or repeal of an existing legislative act may be submitted to the Council by an initiative petition filed in the office of the Clerk. The Council may also submit to the people for vote a proposed legislative act, or proposed amendment or repeal of an existing legislative act, without having first received a petition therefor.

SEC. 27.2525 REFERENDARY PROVISIONS APPLICABLE

Any legislative act proposed by an initiative petition and adopted by the Council, or any legislative act submitted to the voters by the Council with or without having first received a qualifying petition therefor, that has been approved by the voters, shall be subject to the referendary provisions of this article.

SEC. 27.2531 AMENDMENT AND REPEAL: ACTION BY COUNCIL

In addition to the authority granted to the Council by section 27.2523 of this article, the Council may submit to the people any proposed legislative act which would repeal, rescind or amend any legislative act which the people have

previously approved by virtue of an election held pursuant to the initiative provisions of this article. The Council shall not commence proceedings for such submission for a period of one year following the approval of the legislative act by the people.

Section 3. Pursuant to section 17 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, this ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
