ORDINANCE NUMBER O-17113 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON JULY 11, 1988

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 6,
OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING
SECTION 26.08 RELATING TO THE CITIZENS
ADVISORY BOARD ON POLICE/COMMUNITY RELATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 6, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending section 26.08, to read as follows:

SEC. 26.08 CITIZENS ADVISORY BOARD ON POLICE/
COMMUNITY RELATIONS

- A. PURPOSE AND INTENT - no change.
- B. CITIZENS ADVISORY BOARD ON POLICE/
COMMUNITY RELATIONS ESTABLISHED

1. There is hereby created a Citizens Advisory Board on Police/Community Relations consisting of fourteen (14) members who shall serve without compensation. The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The members shall serve until August 29, 1989. The Mayor may designate one (1) member as chairman.

2. All members of the Citizens Advisory Board on Police/Community Relations shall be residents of The City of San Diego. The Board shall include one

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
(1) representative from each Council district provided, however, that any Council Policy with respect to appointments to boards and commissions, notwithstanding, the Mayor shall appoint these members of this Board by obtaining three nominations from each Council district and appointing therefrom; and one (1) member shall be representative from a police employee group; one (1) member shall be human relations expert; one (1) member shall be an expert on youth; one (1) member shall be a member of the judiciary; and two (2) members shall be elected from the social service, corrections, probation, or other related fields. The City Manager, Chief of Police and Policy Psychologist may serve as ex-officio members of said Board. The City Manager shall provide appropriate staff support. The City Attorney shall provide appropriate legal services at each meeting.

C. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS - No change in this section.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


