ORDINANCE NUMBER O-17125 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON AUG 8 1988

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V, ARTICLE 5, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 55.02.201 RELATING TO FIRE CODE FULL COST FEE RECOVERY FOR INSPECTIONS AND PLAN CHECK SERVICES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter V, Article 5, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending section 55.02.201, to read as follows:

SEC. 55.02.201 INSPECTIONS AND PLAN CHECKS AND UNSAFE BUILDINGS FEES

(a) through (c) No Change.

(d) The Fire Chief is authorized to charge fees for the actual cost recovery for overhead and salaries of fire department personnel performing plan checking and inspection services not provided by any other City department for inspection and certification of underground and aboveground hazardous materials storage tanks and for inspection and related plan review services of new buildings and tenant improvements in existing buildings for fire lanes and site access, fire

protection systems, exiting and fire-alarm systems required by the Uniform Fire Code for the following designated occupancies:

1. All public assembly structures, including educational, institutional or large business occupancies and high-rise buildings.
2. Any building in which stock is stored in stacks or piles of eight feet (8') or higher.
3. Paint spray booths.
4. All buildings of four (4) or more stories.
5. All residential occupancies of three (3) or more stories.
6. Apartments with more than fifteen (15) units.
7. Hotels and motels with more than twenty (20) units.

e. Fees under this section shall be determined by the Fire Chief after consultation with an advisory group appointed by the City Manager. The advisory group shall include representatives from the affected industrial sector. The fees shall be promulgated in the City Clerk's Composite Rate Book. Such fees shall be exclusive of any fees for permits required under


any other section of the San Diego Municipal Code
or Fire Code.

f. Unless otherwise provided for, the Fire
Chief may authorize the performance of inspections
and related services for other public agencies on a
cost-reimbursable basis.

**Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force
on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V, ARTICLE 5, OF
THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SEC-
TION 55.02.201 RELATING TO FIRE CODE FULL COST FEE
RECOVERY FOR INSPECTIONS AND PLAN CHECK SER-
VICES.

This ordinance amends section 55.02.201 of the San Diego Municipal Code to authorize fees to be charged for inspections and certification services for hazardous materials storage tanks and for inspection and plan review services in all new construction or improvements in existing structure relative to fire lanes, site access, exiting, and fire alarm and fire protection systems in the following occupancies:

1. All public assembly structures, including educational, institutional or large business occupancies and high-rise buildings.
2. Any building in which stock is stored in stacks or piles of eight feet (8') or higher.
3. Paint spray booths.
4. All buildings of four (4) or more stories.
5. All residential occupancies of three (3) or more stories.
6. Apartments with more than fifteen (15) units.
7. Hotels and motels with more than twenty (20) units.

Fees are to be set by the Fire Chief after consultation with an advisory group appointed by the City Manager. Fees are to be based on cost recovery for overhead and salaries of inspecting personnel. The Fire Chief is further authorized to provide inspections and related services for other public agencies on a cost-reimbursable basis.


