AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 5, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 101.0510.C.4.j. RELATING TO APPLICATION FOR A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT FOR A RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT AND DEMONSTRATION PROJECT FOR HAZARDOUS WASTE TREATMENT IN ANY AGRICULTURAL OR MANUFACTURING ZONE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 5, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 101.0510.C.4.j., to read as follows:

j. Any facility, activity, or use of property in any agricultural or manufacturing zone which is required by federal law to


obtain a Research, Development and
