AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-17127 ADOPTED AUGUST 9, 1988.

WHEREAS, the City Council duly adopted Ordinance No. 0-17127 on August 9, 1988 ordering, calling, providing for and giving notice of a Special Municipal Election to be held in The City of San Diego on November 8, 1988; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the ballot language of Proposition H as set out in Ordinance No. O-17127 to afford the voters a more comprehensive and direct comparison between the measures; and

WHEREAS, a motion was made and seconded to amend the ballot language of Proposition J and said motion failed by a vote of 4 to 4; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. O-17127 be and hereby is amended to provide that Propositions H and J read respectively as follows:

PROPOSITION H. AMENDS THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO PROGRESS GUIDE AND GENERAL PLAN BY ADDING A GROWTH MANAGEMENT ELEMENT.		
Shall the City adopt a Growth Management Element which:		
a. Establishes a maximum limit for the next five years of:		
3,600 new residential units per year, and	Y E S	
3,990 previously approved residential units per year;		
b. Protects single-family neighborhoods by restricting new development;		
c. Preserves environmentally sensitive lands, including wetlands, floodplains, steep slopes, biologically sensitive lands and significant prehistoric and historic sites;		
d. Requires that traffic generated by new development stay within roadway capacity;		
e. Strengthens community plans by requiring periodic comprehensive updates and limiting amendments between updates;	n o	
f. Requires there be adequate public facilities and services at the time of development; and		
g. Establishes regional goals for air quality, water, sewage treatment, solid waste disposal and transportation?		

PROPOSITION J. INITIATIVE MEASURE. AMENDS THE SAN DIEGO GENERAL PLAN.		
Until standards as designated in the initiative are met, shall the City:		
a. Limit residential dwelling units as follows:	Y E S	
FY 1988-89: 7,000 to 9,000 dwelling units		
FY 1989-90: 6,000 to 8,000 dwelling units		
FY 1990-91: 5,000 to 7,000 dwelling units		
FY 1991-92 and each subsequent fiscal year through the FY 2009-2010: 4,000 to 6,000 dwelling units		
b. Develop and implement a plan for industrial and commercial development consistent with the criteria in the initiative;		
c. Develop and implement an allocation system for residential development as provided in the initiative;	n o	
d. Preserve sensitive environmental lands as provided in the initiative;		
e. Adopt a plan for the ultimate development of the City's sphere of influence as provided in the initiative?		
THITTUENCE AS PLOVIDED IN the Initiative:

Section 2. That this amended ordinance shall affect only Proposition H as provided and all other terms and provisions of Ordinance No. O-17127 shall remain as enacted on August 9, 1988.

Section 3. Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter, this ordinance relating to elections shall take effect on SEP 12 1988 being the day of its introduction and passage.
