AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-17122 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. OO-17122-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY AMENDING AND ADDING TO THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF THE BUILDING INSPECTION DEPARTMENT (1300) ONE (1.00) SENIOR CIVIL ENGINEER POSITION; AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR AND COMPTROLLER TO EXPEND THE SUM OF \$66,689 FROM THE BUILDING INSPECTION ENTERPRISE FUND (41300) FOR THE ABOVE POSITION (ALLOCATING \$63,528 TO PERSONNEL SERVICES AND \$3,161 FOR NON-PERSONNEL EXPENSES), ALL RELATED TO REVIEW OF GEOLOGICAL INVESTIGATIONS.

WHEREAS, concern has been expressed for some time that The City of San Diego may be issuing building permits for the construction of new buildings without giving proper consideration to geological hazards that may exist throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, by action taken at the Transportation and Land Use Committee, the City Manager was directed to report back to the Council on the advisability of adopting more stringent requirements for building permits, relating to earthquake faults; and

WHEREAS, in January of 1986, a committee of engineers, architects, geologists and City staff members was formed to determine if the present City requirements for geological investigations in connection with building permits were adequate; and

WHEREAS, the committee determined that the present ordinances are not adequate and that the new regulations should be developed; and

WHEREAS, it was the recommendation of the committee that developed the regulations that the City add to its staff a certified engineering geologist, registered by the State of California to practice specifically as a certified engineering geologist; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager concurs in the recommendation and has recommended the addition to staff of one (1.00) Senior Civil Engineer; and

WHEREAS, the funds for such position will come from the Building Inspection Enterprise Fund and the position to be added by amendment to the annual appropriation ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:


Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-17122 (NEW SERIES), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-17122-1, as amended and adopted therein, by adding to the personnel authorization schedule of the Building Inspection Department. (1300) one (1.00) Senior Civil Engineer position.

Section 2. That the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to expend from the Building

Inspection Enterprise Fund (41300) the sum of \$66,689 for said additional position, for the purpose of fully funding the above newly authorized position for the remainder of fiscal year 1989, allocating \$63,528 to Personnel Services for salary and wages, and \$3,161 to Non-Personnel expenses related to the program of reviewing geological investigation reports.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two public hearings, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.
