AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 17098 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89" TO CREATE THE NEW POSITION OF ASSISTANT INVESTMENT OFFICER; EXEMPTING THE POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AMENDING EXHIBIT C TO SAID ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE SAID POSITION IN MANAGERIAL CATEGORY "B"; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized an Assistant Investment Officer position in the City Treasurer's department in the fiscal year 1988-89 budget; and

WHEREAS, said classification must be established in the annual salary ordinance and exempted from the Classified Service as requested; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission reviewed the justification for the exemption on August 11, 1988 and has commented favorably; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual salary ordinance to create said position, establish an appropriate rate of compensation therefor, and exempt said position from the Classified Service; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 17098 (NEW SERIES), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF

COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89" be and the same is hereby further amended by creating and establishing the position of Assistant Investment Officer.

Section 2. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission on August 11, 1988 as meeting the Charter criteria for exemption from the Classified Service, and after having considered and reviewed the report thereon from the Civil Service Commission, attached hereto as Attachment "A", the Council deems exemption appropriate and the position created in section 1 above be and the same is hereby declared to be in the Unclassified Service of The City of San Diego.

Section 3. That said Ordinance No. 17098 (NEW SERIES) be and it is hereby further amended to amend Exhibit C thereto so as to reflect said position designation of Assistant Investment Officer in Managerial Category B.

Section 4. As a schedule of compensation for the position established and enumerated above, the position of Assistant Investment Officer is hereby authorized at salary ranges of 07.3, 07.4 and 07.5.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

SUBJECT: UNCLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES - CHARTER SECTION 117

On August 11, 1988, the Civil Service Commission received a request from the City Treasurer to exempt a new Assistant Investment Officer position from the Classified Service.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "Managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council."

Upon review of the duties and responsibilities to be performed, the Commission finds that this position does meet the criteria of the Charter and supports exemption from the Classified Service. If additional information would be of assistance in your consideration of this matter, staff is available to respond with details as necessary.

Section 3. That said Ordinance No. 17098 (NEW SERIES) be and it is hereby further amended to amend Exhibit C thereto so as to reflect said position designation of Assistant Investment Officer in Managerial Category B.

Section 4. As a schedule of compensation for the position established and enumerated above, the position of Assistant Investment Officer is hereby authorized at salary ranges of 07.3/07.4 and 07.5.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
