BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City
Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably
by the Civil Service Commission on August 11, 1988, the new
Deputy Director position in the Park and Recreation Department
(440), Open Space Division (44610) be and it is hereby exempted
from the Classified Service and declared to be in the
Unclassified Service of The City of San Diego.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. O-17122 (NEW SERIES), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-17122-1, as amended and adopted therein, by making and reflecting such exemption from the Classified Service of the Deputy Director position to the personnel authorization schedule of the Park and Recreation Department 440, Open Space Division (44610).

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the above unclassified position recited in sections 1 and 2 hereof, the

salary rate set forth in Salary Rates 7.7, 7.8 and 7.9 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Managerial Category C, contained in Exhibit C to Ordinance No. O-17098 (New Series), be and the same is hereby adopted.
