ADOPTED ON OCT 10 1988

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-17098 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89" BY AMENDING EXHIBIT B THERETO TO CREATE AND ADD A NEW CLASS ENTITLED "SENIOR MECHANICAL ENGINEER" IN THE ENGINEERING OCCUPATIONAL GROUP; AMENDING EXHIBITS A-1 AND A-2 OF SAID ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE A NEW SALARY RATE NUMBER 83.0 FOR SAID POSITION IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE, AS SET FORTH IN ATTACHMENT A HERETO; AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-270952 TO PLACE THE NEWLY CREATED CLASS IN THE SUPERVISORY REPRESENTATION UNIT; AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-270951 TO APPROVE AND DECLARE THE ABOVE NEWLY CREATED CLASS AS ELIGIBLE FOR REGULAR RATE OVERTIME BY PLACING IT IN GROUP C OF SAID OVERTIME ELIGIBILITY RESOLUTION NO. R-270951.

WHEREAS, the Engineering and Development Department has requested the creation of a new Senior Mechanical Engineer classification to supervise the section responsible for managing consultant contracts for the design and construction of public buildings and facilities; and

WHEREAS, this position, which is presently classified as a Project Officer II, will also serve as the department's mechanical engineering expert in the preparation of proposals, cost estimates, and design of plumbing, heating, ventilation, air conditioning, and other mechanical systems; and

WHEREAS, duties are many and varied, as set forth with specificity in the Personnel Director's Report to the Mayor and Council, dated September 8, 1988; and

WHEREAS, the specified duties and responsibilities require professional mechanical engineering experience performing design, review, and inspection of building, plumbing, heating, ventilating and air conditioning systems; and

WHEREAS, registration as a professional mechanical engineer with the State of California is also required, so therefore, the present classification of Project Officer II is no longer appropriate; and

WHEREAS, since no existing City classification meets these requirements, it is recommended that a new classification of Senior Mechanical Engineer be created with a salary of \$3,390 to \$4,103 per month until December 29, 1988; and \$3,458 to \$4,185 per month from December 30, 1988 to June 30, 1989; and

WHEREAS, it is also recommended that this class be eligible for regular rate overtime under the same conditions as other professional level engineering class which are included in Group C of the Addendum to Personnel Manual Section H-4, "Overtime"; and

WHEREAS, included in the group are those classes designated as exempt from the overtime provisions of the Fair Labor Standards Act but eligible for regular rate overtime in accordance with City policy; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-17098 (NEW SERIES), entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL

YEAR 1988-89" be and the same is hereby amended by amending Exhibit B thereto by creating and adding a new class, entitled "SENIOR MECHANICAL ENGINEER" in the Engineering Occupation Group at salary rate number 83.0.


Section 2. That Exhibits A-1 and A-2 of the above-cited ordinance be amended to include a new salary rate number 83.0, ranging from \$3,390 to \$4,103 [A-1] and \$3,458 to \$4,185 [A-2] per month, at rates and steps as set forth in Attachment A hereto.

Section 3. That Resolution No. R-270952, be and it is hereby amended to place the newly created class of SENIOR MECHANIC ENGINEER in the Supervisory Representation Unit.

Section 4. That Resolution No. R-270951, be and it is hereby amended by approving and declaring the newly created class as eligible for regular rate overtime and placing said newly created class in Group C Overtime Eligibility.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

This ordinance amends the annual salary ordinance to create and establish a new class in the classified service, entitled "SENIOR MECHANICAL ENGINEER" and places said new class in the Engineering Occupational Group. The ordinance also establishes a salary rate for the class at 83.0. Finally, the ordinance places the class in the supervisory representation unit and declares the newly created class as eligible for regular rate overtime.
