AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-17098 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89" TO CREATE THE NEW CLASSIFICATION OF GRANTS COORDINATOR; AMENDING EXHIBIT C TO SAID ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE SAID CLASSIFICATION OF GRANTS COORDINATOR IN MANAGERIAL CATEGORY "B"; EXEMPTING SAID POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized an additional Endowment Officer in the fiscal year 1988-89 budget for the Intergovernmental Relations Department in the Endowment/Grants Program (0155); and

WHEREAS, it is now desired and requested that this additional position title be changed to read "Grants Coordinator"; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the annual salary ordinance to establish such classification title in the Table of Classifications and exempt said position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, it is intended, upon establishment of such classification, to amend the annual budget reflect one (1.00)

Grants Coordinator in lieu of one (1.00) Endowment Officer; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 0-17098 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89" be and the same is hereby further amended by creating and establishing the classification of Grants Coordinator.

Section 2. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission on November 3, 1988 as meeting the Charter criteria for exemption from the Classified Service, and after having considered and reviewed the report thereon from the Civil Service Commission, attached hereto as Attachment "A", the Council deems exemption appropriate and the positions created in section 1 above be and the same is hereby declared to be in the Unclassified Service of The City of San Diego.

Section 3. That said Ordinance No. O-17098 (New Series) be and it is amended by amending Exhibit C thereto so as to reflect said Grants Coordinator classification in Managerial Category "B".

Section 4. As a schedule of compensation for the classification established and enumerated above, the Grants Coordinator is hereby authorized at salary ranges 07.3, 07.4, and 07.5.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

Exemption of Grants Coordinator Position from the

Classified Service

On November 3, 1988, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Intergovernmental Relations Director to exempt a new Grants Coordinator position from the Classified Service.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "Managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council."

Upon review of the duties and responsibilities to be performed, the Commission finds that this position does meet the criteria of the Charter and supports exemption from the Classified Service. If additional information would be of assistance in your consideration of this matter, staff is available to respond with details as necessary.
