AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 6, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 26.3401 RELATING TO THE CREATION OF A WASTE MANAGEMENT ADVISORY BOARD.

WHEREAS, the matter of establishing a Waste Management Advisory Board was presented to the Rules Committee in City Manager's Report No. 88-210, dated April 15, 1988; and

WHEREAS, such action as recommended by the City Manager was approved by a 3-0 vote; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that the Waste Management Advisory Board should be established pursuant to Section 43(a) of the City Charter in that the matters and issues are not temporary in nature; and

WHEREAS, the matter of establishing such Board is now forwarded to the full Council for action; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 6, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended by adding Section 26.3401 to read as follows:

SEC. 26.3401 WASTE MANAGEMENT ADVISORY BOARD

A. PURPOSE AND INTENT

It is the purpose and intent of the City Council to establish a Waste Management Advisory Board, to serve as

an advisory body to the Mayor, City Council and City
Manager on public policy matters relating to the
collection and disposal of waste including recycling,
waste reduction, landfilling and alternative methods of
waste disposal.

It is further the purpose and intent of the City
Council to make available to City government the talents
of those involved in various disciplines; generally
including representation from the following
organizations and/or interests: environmental groups,
taxpayers' interest groups, business, recyclers, refuse
disposal interests, and community at large.

B. WASTE MANAGEMENT ADVISORY BOARD ESTABLISHED

There is hereby created a Waste Management Advisory
Board consisting of nine (9) members, who shall serve
without compensation. The members shall be appointed by
the Mayor and confirmed by the Council.

The members shall serve two (2) year terms and each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed. The members shall be appointed in such manner that the terms of not more than five (5) members shall expire in any year. The expiration date of all terms shall be October 1. During October of each year, the Mayor may designate one (1) member as Chairperson; however, in the absence of such designation, the Board shall on or after November 15 select a Chairperson from among its members. Any vacancy shall be filled for the

unexpired term of the member whose place becomes vacant.

The Board shall adopt rules consistent with the law for
the government of its business and procedures.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
