AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-17098 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89" TO CREATE THE NEW CLASSIFICATIONS OF BINATIONAL AFFAIRS OFFICER AND ASSISTANT BINATIONAL AFFAIRS OFFICER; AMENDING EXHIBIT C TO SAID ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE SAID NEW CLASSIFICATIONS IN MANAGERIAL CATEGORIES C AND B, RESPECTIVELY, AND TO DELETE THE CLASSIFICATIONS OF BINATIONAL AFFAIRS DIRECTOR AND ASSISTANT BINATIONAL AFFAIRS DIRECTOR FROM EXECUTIVE CATEGORIES III AND II, RESPECTIVELY; ESTABLISHING SALARY RATES FOR THE NEWLY CREATED MANAGERIAL CLASSIFICATIONS; AND EXEMPTING SAID NEW POSITIONS FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, during the budget hearings on June 13, 1988, City Council approved, in concept, the transfer of Binational Affairs from the City Manager's jurisdiction to the Office of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, City Manager's Report No. 88-465, dated September 19, 1988, provides an in-depth discussion of the matter and the actions necessary to effectuate said transfer of duties; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the salary ordinance to delete the classifications of Binational Affairs Director and Assistant Director and replace them, in lieu thereof, with a Binational Affairs Officer and Assistant Binational Affairs Officer as unclassified positions in the Managerial Category "C" and "B" respectively of Exhibit C to the salary ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-17098 (New Series) as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89" be and the same is hereby further amended by creating and establishing the positions of Binational Affairs Officer and Assistant Binational Affairs Officer.

Section 2. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission on November 3, 1988 as meeting the Charter criteria for exemption from the Classified Service, and after having considered and reviewed the report thereon from the Civil Service Commission, attached hereto as Attachment "A", the Council deems exemption appropriate and the positions created in section 1 above be and the same is hereby declared to be in the Unclassified Service of The City of San Diego.

Section 3. That said Ordinance No. 17098 (New Series) be and it is hereby further amended to amend Exhibit C thereto so as to reflect said position designations of Binational Affairs Officer in Managerial Category C and Assistant Binational Affairs Officer in Managerial Category B.

Section 4. As a schedule of compensation for the positions established and enumerated above, the position of Binational Affairs Officer is hereby authorized at a salary range of 07.7, 07.8 and 07.9 and Assistant Binational Affairs Officer at a salary range of 07.3, 07.4 and 07.5.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

Classified Service

On November 3, 1988, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Mayor's Office to exempt the positions of Binational Affairs Officer and Assistant Binational Affairs Officer from the Classified Service.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "Managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council."

Upon review of the duties and responsibilities to be performed, the Commission finds that these positions meet the criteria of the Charter and supports exemption from the Classified Service. If additional information would be of assistance in your consideration of this matter, staff is available to respond with details as necessary.

This ordinance amends the annual salary ordinance by creating the new classifications of Binational Affairs Officer and Assistant Binational Affairs Officer. It further amends Exhibit C to said salary ordinance to include the new classifications in Managerial Categories 30° and "B", respectively and to delete the classifications of Binational Affairs Director and Assistant Binational Affairs Director from the Executive Categories III and II, respectively. Finally, this ordinance exempts said newly created positions from the Classified Service and establishes salary rates therefor.
