WHEREAS, the list of appointees was presented to the Rules Committee on March 16, 1988 and approved unanimously by said committee; and

WHEREAS, it is now further desired to appoint individuals to serve as members of the Commission and take other action deemed necessary in connection therewith; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:


1. That Resolution No. R-269812, dated November 23, 1987 be and the same is hereby amended to change the title of the Committee created therein from "City Charter Review Committee" to "San Diego City Charter Review Commission - '88."

That this Council hereby fully acknowledges and declares that all recommendations made by the Commission shall be placed directly on the ballot without further Council directive except for those legislative actions required by the State Elections Code, the City Charter and applicable provisions of the Municipal Code to place the matters on the ballot.
- 5. That this Council further understands and acknowledges that said Commission may seek to place some of its recommendations on the November 1988 ballot, with possible further recommendations to be presented to the electorate in 1989 and, in accordance therewith, fully accepts and authorizes such actions.



6. That Robert S. Teaze, attorney-at-law, be and he is hereby selected to serve as special independent counsel to the Commission, said service to be more fully explicated by letter agreement authorized by separate Council action.
