WHEREAS, Steven Patrick Garvey played Major League Baseball for eighteen seasons, the last five in San Diego with the Padres; and

WHEREAS, he earned the admiration of his teammates, fellow baseball players and fans around the world for his outstanding achievements; and

WHEREAS, he was voted to represent the National League as a member of the All-Star Team ten times and was voted the Most Valuable Player in the 1978 All-Star Game; and

WHEREAS, he currently holds or is tied for eleven Major League records and eight League Championship Series records; and

WHEREAS, he was selected the Most Valuable Player in the 1984 National League Series in which he hit the most dramatic game-winning home run in Padres' history, the series which helped propel the San Diego Padres to win their first National League pennant and a chance to compete in the 1984 World Series; and

WHEREAS, he has demonstrated an immeasurable commitment to the people of San Diego through his extensive involvement with many charities, including The Multiple Sclerosis Society, Children's Hospital, Just Say No to Drugs, Special Olympics, and the Arthritis Foundation; and

WHEREAS, his sincerity, hard work, and perseverance have provided an exemplary model for all youth to emulate; NOW, THEREFORE,


