RESOLUTION NUMBER R-270785 ADOPTED ON APRIL 19, 1988

WHEREAS, on April 19, 1988, the Council of The City of San Diego ("Council") considered the Interim Development Ordinance ("IDO") Accelerated Variance Application No. 87-2291, by Gregory Bianco, to construct a 4-unit multi-family project (includes proposed and existing units) at 5919 Mildred Street, Assessor's Parcel No. 436-421-03, zoned R-1000, in the Linda Vista Community; and

WHEREAS, the request for Accelerated Variance submitted by Gregory Bianco pursuant to the IDO Section 7.B.3., requires the project to consist of not more than three (3) dwelling units or not more than three (3) multi-family dwelling units on a single lot; and

WHEREAS, the request for Accelerated Variance submitted is governed by IDO Section 7.B.4., pursuant to which units granted will be taken from the reserve allocation as set forth in Schedule A of the IDO as modified by the procedures set forth in Resolution No. R-269742 adopted by the Council on November 16, 1987; and

WHEREAS, in arriving at their decision, the Council considered the staff report, the decision of the IDO Administrator, reviewed the plans and materials submitted prior to and at the public hearing, and heard public testimony presented at the hearing; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the application for Accelerated Variance of Gregory Bianco is hereby granted, and, therefore, overturns the decision of the IDO Administrator.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in arriving at its decision, the Council made the following findings:

- 1. Units are available from future quarterly allocations of the community based on Resolution No. R-269095, Schedule A.
- 2. The project is consistent with the adopted Community Plan, and Progress Guide and General Plan. There are no applicable Community Plan revisions pending.
- 3. The project complies with applicable zoning, and is exempt from the Linda Vista Emergency Ordinance.
- 4. The project will not result in material damage or prejudice to other property in the vicinity, nor be detrimental to the public health, safety or general welfare.
- 5. A construction delay on the project would significantly impede the ability of Gregory Bianco to proceed at some future time.
- 6. Absent growth management provisions of the IDO necessitating the application and approval process described in Sections 6. and 7. of the IDO, the project could proceed.
- 7. The project was unanimously approved by the Linda Vista Community Planning Committee.
- 8. Length of ownership and occupancy plans demonstrate substantial commitment to community welfare and fostering the Community Plan.

9. Gregory Bianco has presented financial evidence of readiness to proceed.
