RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 270865

ADOPTED ON MAY 02 1988

WHEREAS, the Pacific Southwest Railway Museum Association, Inc. was incorporated in 1963 as a nonprofit, tax exempt, public benefit corporation, and is now celebrating the 25th anniversary of its establishment; and

WHEREAS, the museum has recently established "San Diego Railroad Museum" (Museum) as its operating name; and

WHEREAS, the Museum has preserved the railroad history and heritage of the City and County of San Diego, and of the Pacific Southwest through the restoration of historic locomotive, rail cars, and equipment, and of the depot at La Mesa; and

WHEREAS, the Museum provides an educational service to the people of San Diego in keeping the traditions of old time railroading alive in its weekly rail excursions from Campo on the San Diego & Arizona Eastern right-of-way, under lease from the Metropolitan Transit Development Board; and

WHEREAS, the Museum is hosting Southern California's first railroad historical exhibition in San Diego May 5 through 8, 1988, as RailFair '88; and

WHEREAS, the Museum has achieved its present stature entirely through the efforts of its dedicated volunteers and the support of its 2,000 members and corporate benefactors; and

WHEREAS, the Museum plans during 1988 to establish a permanent exhibit facility in central San Diego, thereby bringing

to the San Diego public and to visitors the lively story of railroads' role in the history of San Diego and the Pacific Southwest through a series of interactive displays and technological exhibits; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of all its citizens, extends its congratulations to the San Diego Railroad Museum on its 25th anniversary, and further expresses its appreciation to the volunteers and members of the Museum for their efforts in preserving an important part of the San Diego's history for posterity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the week of May 1 through 8, 1988, be and it is hereby declared "RailFair '88 Week" in commemoration of the events planned for the railroad yard at Hancock Street, near Old Town, San Diego.
