WHEREAS, the San Diego Open Space Park Facilities District  
No. 1 was established by Council Resolution No. 220486 on March  
20, 1978; and

WHEREAS, said district by the terms of the resolution  
included all of the property within the boundaries of the City of  
San Diego; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate and desirable that said property  
which has been annexed to The City of San Diego, be annexed to  
the San Diego Open Space Park Facilities District No. 1; and


WHEREAS, Section 61.2070 of the San Diego Municipal Code of  
The City of San Diego, provides for the annexation of property to  
a park facilities district; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that  
its intention is hereby expressed to conduct a hearing which will  
be held in the Council Chambers on the 12th Floor of the City  
Administration Building, 202 "C" Street, San Diego, California,  
on June 28, 1988, at 10:00 a.m., at which time the Council will  
consider whether or not to annex the "Scripps Miramar Ranch  
Annexation," as more particularly described in Exhibit A attached  
hereto, to the Open Space Park Facilities District No. 1.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the owners of said property or any portion thereof may appear at the hearing and be heard, orally or by writing, signed by them, and may present evidence in support of or in opposition to the proposed annexation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is hereby directed to post a copy of this resolution on the bulletin board of the City Administration Building and to cause a copy of this resolution to be published in the Daily Transcript once a week for two weeks prior to the hearing, the posting and first publication to be on or before the tenth day prior to the day of the hearing.

All that territory in the County of San Diego, State of California, lying within the following described boundaries:

Beginning at the corner common to Sections 26, 27, 34 and 35 Township 14 south, Range 2 west, San Bernardino Base and Meridian;

1. Thence northerly along the east line of said Section 27, to the north line of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of said Section 27;
2. Thence westerly along said north line of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 27, to the east line of the west half of said southeast quarter of Section 27;
3. Thence northerly along said east line of the west half of the southeast quarter of Section 27, to the north line of said west half of the southeast quarter of Section 27;
4. Thence westerly along said north line of the west half of the southeast quarter of Section 27, to the easterly line of the west half of said Section 27, being also a point on the San Diego city boundary line established by Resolution Number 195510, adopted December 12, 1968, by the San Diego City Council;
5. Thence along said city boundary northerly to the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 27;
6. Thence westerly along the northerly line of said southeast quarter of the northwest quarter to the southeast corner of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 27;
7. Thence northerly along the easterly line of said northwest quarter of the northwest quarter to the northeast corner thereof, also being a point in the southerly line of Section 22, said Township and Range;
8. Thence along the city boundary line as established by Ordinance No. 10336, adopted July 7, 1970, easterly to the corner common to Sections 22, 23, 26 and 27, Township 14 south, Range 2 west, being a point in the boundary of the City of Poway as established by Board of Supervisor's resolution adopted November 25, 1980, Item 11;
9. Thence along said boundary line southerly along the westerly line of Section 26 to the east-west center line of said Section 26;
10. Thence easterly along said east-west center line to the north-south center line of said Section 26;

11. Thence northerly along the north-south center line to a point on the northeasterly line of Pomerado Road (formerly Mission Road 1-A), map on file in the County Engineer's Office of said county;
12. Thence easterly and southeasterly along the northerly and easterly line of Pomerado Road to a point in the northerly boundary of the United States Naval Reservation boundary as said Naval Reservation boundary is described in Decree of Taking recorded April 16, 1942 in the office of the Recorder of San Diego County in Book 1342, Page 14 of Official Records; said point of intersection being in the southerly right-of-way line of Pomerado Road (Mission Road 1-A) and a portion of the San Diego city boundary line as established by their Ordinance No. 8319, adopted July 29, 1980, by said city;
13. Thence generally southwesterly, southerly, and southwesterly along the boundary of said City of San Diego to an intersection with the east line of Section 34, said Township and Range;
14. Thence leaving said city boundary line and the southerly right-of-way line of Pomerado Road (Mission Road 1-A) and proceeding northerly along said east line of Section 34, to the section corner common to Sections 26, 27, 34 and 35, also being the point of beginning.


