WHEREAS, the President's fiscal year 1989 budget proposes that the Urban Mass Transportation Administration discretionary funding be eliminated and operating subsidies be restricted to cities under 20,000 population; and

WHEREAS, these reductions are proposed to be used for increases to nontransit federal activities, which have other sources of funding available to them; and

WHEREAS, the federal transit operating assistance to the San Diego region has been reduced by thirty percent over the past seven years; and

WHEREAS, elimination of federal transit operating assistance will result in devastating cutbacks in service at a time when metropolitan transit system ridership and farebox recovery trends are both positive; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council does hereby register its strong support for maintaining the federal mass transit program at existing fiscal year 1988 funding levels for fiscal year 1989 and urges that the San Diego congressional delegation lend their support to H. Res. 400 and S. Res. 394, as set forth more fully in IRD Report No. 88-10, dated April 14, 1988.
