RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 271005 ADOPTED ON MAY 161988

APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUNDS FOR THE CEDAR RIDGE PARK, LOMITA NEIGHBORHOOD PARK, PARADISE HILLS COMMUNITY PARK - IMPROVEMENTS, PHASE II, TROLLEY BARN PARK AND SAIL BAY PHASE III (FANUEL STREET - PARK AND STAGING AREA) PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the Congress under Public Law 88-578 has authorized the establishment of a Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant-In-Aid Program, providing matching funds to the State of California and its political subdivisions for acquiring lands and developing facilities for public outdoor recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation is responsible for the administration of the program within the State, setting up necessary rules and procedures governing application by local agencies under the program; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Cedar Ridge Park, Lomita Neighborhood Park, Paradise Hills Community Park - Improvements, Phase II, Trolley Barn Park, and Sail Bay III (Fanuel Street - Park and Staging Area) projects are consistent with the Statewide Comprehensive Recreation Resources Plan: California Outdoor Recreation Plan - 1988; and

WHEREAS, the project must be compatible with the land use plans of those jurisdictions immediately surrounding the project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Council hereby approves the filing of an application for Land and Water Conservation Fund assistance.
- 2. That the Council hereby certifies that said agency has matching funds from the following sources; Cedar Ridge Park (Park North-East Park Development Fund) Lomita Neighborhood Park (Revenue Sharing, Roberti-Z'berg Harris Open Space and Recreation Program, and Park Service District Fees); Paradise Hills Community Park Improvements, Phase II (Revenue Sharing, Park Fees, and 1984 State Bond Act); Trolley Barn Park (Capital Outlay and Park Service District Fees); and Sail Bay Phase III (Fanuel Street Park and Staging Area) (Capital Outlay) and can finance one hundred percent (100%) of the project, with up to fifty percent (50%) reimbursement.
- 3. That the Council hereby certifies that the project is compatible with the land use plans of those jurisdictions immediately surrounding the project.
- 4. That the Council hereby appoints the City Manager, or his representative, as agent of the City of San Diego to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, billing

statements, and so on which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
