ADOPTED ON MAY 161988

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1974, voters approved Propositions XX and YY which permitted the San Diego Unified School District (District) to enter into a lease-purchase agreement for the construction, landscaping, and furnishing of new school facilities; and

WHEREAS, the action permitted the District to levy a tax for the years 1975-76 through 2002-03; and

WHEREAS, the measure financed the construction of twenty-one school projects; and

WHEREAS, after the passage of Proposition 13, the 38.3-cents authorized in 1974 for each \$100 of assessed valuation was converted to a 9.575-cents rate and in 1986-87, the District utilized the tax rate in the amount of 2.250-cents which results in 7.325-cents remaining for use; and

WHEREAS, state legislation approved in 1987 authorizes the District to seek simple majority voter approval to levy an additional increment of tax to acquire and equip new facilities on a lease-purchase basis; and

WHEREAS, Council is concerned that there are not adequate classrooms and facilities for our school children; and

WHEREAS, in the next twelve years, our school district population will increase by nearly 35,000 students; and

WHEREAS, the District is seeking voter approval of a facilities construction proposition at the June 7, 1988 primary election; and

WHEREAS, approval of the proposition by a simple majority would allow the District to levy the unused portion of the tax, up to 9.575-cents per \$100 of assessed valuation, which was authorized by the voters in 1974 and this amount would be used to construct and equip new school facilities on a lease-purchase basis; and

WHEREAS, among others, Proposition Y is supported by the San Diego Chamber of Commerce and the League of Women Voters; and

WHEREAS, the background and discussion thereon is set forth in IRD Report No. 88-16, dated May 2, 1988, which was presented to and approved unanimously (4-0) by the Rules Committee on May 4, 1988; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to forward the matter of support for Proposition Y to the full Council for action thereon; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby support and encourages the public to support by its affirmative vote, Proposition Y on the June 1988 ballot, said

proposition entitled, "Local School Facilities Construction Finance Measure."
