## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 271286

ADOPTED ON JUN 27 1988

WHEREAS, there have been public concerns over the alarming rate of the depletion of the earth's ozone layer; and

WHEREAS, a second hole in the ozone layer has been detected over North America; and

WHEREAS, the depletion of the ozone layer has been linked to an increased rate of skin cancer; and

WHEREAS, the use of fully halogenated chloroflourocarbons (CFC's) has been linked to the depletion of the ozone layer; and

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego has endorsed AB 3761 which calls for a ban in the State of California of the sale, manufacture, and distribution of plastics manufactured with fully halogenated CFC's by January 1, 1990; and

WHEREAS, alternative blowing agents, including HCFC-22 and Pentane, which reduce the impact on the ozone layer in excess of ninety-five percent (95%), are available; and

WHEREAS, non-degradable convenience fast food packaging is a part of the country's growing litter problem; and

WHEREAS, polystyrene plastic is non-degradable and used in fast food or packaging containers and has an indefinite life span and is the fastest growing element of the country's litter problem; and

WHEREAS, local landfills have reached or will reach capacity within ten years; and

WHEREAS, some resolution of the increasingly serious problem is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego has recognized that the most effective means of extending the life of the City's landfills is to prevent recyclable material from reaching the landfill; and

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego has adopted a goal of twenty-five percent (25%) recycling; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of said City, discourages the use by all public and private entities of fully halogenated CFC manufactured plastics.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager be and he is hereby directed to develop and implement guidelines for eliminating, by January 1, 1990, the use of fully halogenated CFC containing plastics.
