RESOLUTION NUMBER R-271407 ADOPTED ON JULY 12, 1988

WHEREAS, on July 12, 1988, the Council of The City of San Diego ("Council") considered the Interim Development Ordinance ("IDO") Non-Accelerated Variance Application No. 88-4145, by James A. Lester, to construct an 8-unit project (includes proposed units and any existing units) located at 3740-52 Promontory Street which is described as Lots 30, 31, 32, 33 and 34, Block 32, Map No. 895 (APN 423-443-15, 16, 17), zoned R-1500, in the Pacific Beach Community; and

WHEREAS, the request for Non-Accelerated Variance submitted by James A. Lester pursuant to the IDO Section 7.C.3.

WHEREAS, the request for Non-Accelerated Variance submitted is governed by IDO Section 7.C.4., pursuant to which units granted will be taken from the reserve allocation as set forth in Schedule A of the IDO as modified by the procedures set forth in Resolution No. R-269742 adopted by the Council on November 16, 1987; and

WHEREAS, in arriving at their decision, the Council considered the staff report, the decision of the IDO Administrator, reviewed the plans and materials submitted prior to and at the public hearing, and heard public testimony presented at the hearing; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the application for Non-Accelerated Variance of James A. Lester

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is hereby granted and, therefore, overturns the decision of the IDO Administrator.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in arriving at its decision, the Council made the following findings:

- 1. Project esthetically enhances the community.
- 2. The project is consistent with the adopted Community Plan, and Progress Guide and General Plan.
 - 3. The project complies with applicable zoning.
- 4. The project will not result in material damage or prejudice to other property in the vicinity, nor be detrimental to the public health, safety or general welfare.
- 5. A construction delay on the project would significantly impede the ability of James A. Lester to proceed at some future time.
- 6. Absent growth management provisions of the IDO necessitating the application and approval process described in Sections 6. and 7. of the IDO, the project could proceed.
- 7. Length of ownership and occupancy plans demonstrate substantial commitment to community welfare and fostering the Community Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby incorporates those findings contained in Planning Department Memorandum dated July 12, 1988, to the Honorable Mayor O'Connor and City Council regarding Interim Development Ordinance Variance Request - Variance Criteria Analysis, IDO No. 88-4145, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-271407.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the units granted by the Council pursuant to this Non-Accelerated Variance shall come from the reserve.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the decision of the Council shall be final.
