BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council for The City of San Diego, that it hereby expresses its support of the above-mentioned three (3) week celebration of Soviet art and culture.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the City Council, that it approves in concept the proposed San Diego Soviet Arts Festival, planned for October/November 1989, and further set out in Exhibit A.

PROTOCOL

- 1. The Ministry of Culture of the U.S.S.R. and the City of San Diego confirm by this document their agreement to realize a San Diego Festival of Soviet Art and Culture.
- 2. The Festival of Soviet Art and Culture will take place in San Diego, California, U.S.A., in October and November of 1989 and will include Icons from Tbilisi, Georgia; Faberge Eggs from the Armory Musuem in Moscow (subject to the inclusion of the Forbes Faberge Eggs in the San Diego exhibit); and the Tbilisi Marionettes (including the director); and a joint production by the San Diego Opera Company of Boris Gudonov with Conductor Jansug Kakhidze and five soloists from the Soviet Union.
- 3. Still under negotiation are performances by or for the Symphony, Folk Dancers, other visual and performing artists, jazz musicians, cinema, photographic exhibits and other Musuem exhibits.
- 4. Under negotiation from Tbilisi, Georgia, are a Folk-Craft exhibit with accompanying craftsmen; a children's toy exhibit; children's folk dance group; a muralist, chefs; and possibly a theater group.
- 5. The final number of performers and participants in the Festival in San Diego will be determined by mutual consents.
- 6. Financial arrangements will be provided in separate contracts.
- 7. As plans are developed, it is understood that some details of this agreement may need to be amplified or modified, and this will be done by mutual consents.
