WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego held a public hearing on May 5, 1988, to consider the proposed amendment to the Scripps Miramar Ranch Community Plan for the purpose of designating 12 acres on the Fairbrook Elementary School site, south of Pomerado Road for a neighborhood park if this site is determined to be unnecessary for school use, 13 to 20 acres on the secondary school site, located between Scripps Ranch Boulevard and Interstate 25 for a community park, and a 17-acre site, south of Pomerado Road in Carroll Canyon for a resource-based park; redesignating a 13-acre community park site at the eastern end of Miramar Lake on Miramar Point as a neighborhood park and a 45-acre park site in the area known as the County Island as improved open space; correcting the parks, recreation and open space map and text to accurately reflect the classification of Hoyt Park West as improved open space rather than park and Aviary Park as a park rather than open space; and incorporating into the Community Plan two motions approved by the City Council concerning the widening of Pomerado Road and the opening of the same road upon the completion of Alternative 8A; and
