A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO ESTABLISH THE OCEAN BEACH BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT PURSUANT TO THE PARKING AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA LAW OF 1979.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego desires to form a parking and business improvement area to be known as "Ocean Beach Business Improvement District" pursuant to the Parking and Business Improvement Area Law of 1979 (Streets and Highways Code section 36500 et seq.), in accordance with the wishes of the many businesses in the area; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The Council hereby declares its intention to form a parking and business improvement area to be known as "Ocean Beach Business Improvement District" (the "District") pursuant to the Parking and Business Improvement Area Law of 1979 (Streets and Highways Code section 36500 et seq.)
- 2. The area to be included in the District includes the Ocean Beach community area within the following address ranges:

- 3. The purpose of forming the aforementioned District as a parking and business improvement area under the aforementioned Business and Improvement Area Law is to provide revenue to defray the costs of services and programs which will benefit businesses in the area. The services and programs to be provided are those listed in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, and the services and programs listed thereon are the uses to which the revenue generated by the assessments to be levied will be put.
- 4. All businesses operating in the above-described area will be assessed a share of the costs of the aforementioned services and programs according to the type of business and the benefit to be received as determined by the following:

- A. Description of the District Zones:
- Zone 1 is all businesses on Newport Avenue.
 Businesses in this area will receive the greatest benefit from the promotional activities of the District.
- 2. Zone 2 is all businesses on Voltaire Street and West Point Loma Boulevard. It is anticipated that businesses in this Zone will still receive a benefit, but not of the same magnitude as those directly on Newport Avenue.
 - 3. Zone 3 is all remaining street designations.
- B. Description of the District Categories of Benefit:
- 1. CATEGORY A includes those businesses which will benefit most significantly from the increased awareness of Ocean Beach as a place to do business and from an increase in foot and automobile traffic expected to be the end-product of the promotional activities of the District. The Category includes, but is not limited to:

2. CATEGORY B includes those businesses which interact with the public to a lesser extent than CATEGORY A, but these businesses will benefit from the increased awareness of Ocean Beach as a place to do business and from an increase in foot and automobile traffic expected to be the end-product of the promotional activities of the District. The Category includes but is not limited to:

Accountants/Secretarial Services Advertising Agencies Architects Attorneys Business Management Firms Dentists Designers Dispensing Opticians Engineers Film and Video Production Companies General Contractors Hair Salons and Barbers Hospitals/Medical Services/Health Services Interior Decorators Investigative Services Investment Companies Laboratories Medical Doctors Mortuaries/Funeral Homes Nonprofit Organizations Nursery Schools Optometrists Pet Grooming Photography Studios Psychologists Printing Real Estate Offices Security Services Social Workers Storage Facilities Utility Companies Wholesale Manufacturing/Distributors

3. CATEGORY C includes all apartments of six or more units.

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- 4. Businesses not specifically identified in CATEGORIES A, B or C shall be categorized by the City Treasurer upon application for a City general business tax certificate.
- C. The assessments to be imposed for those District businesses by Zone and Category of Benefit are as follows:

The above-described assessment is an annual charge and shall be levied, collected and enforced in the same manner, at the same time, and with the same penalties and interest as in the case of the general business tax. For those businesses taxed for other than an annual tax period, the City Treasurer shall determine the assessment to be levied upon issuance of the City business tax certificate.

The total assessment collected from any business under the provisions of the ordinance shall not exceed \$90.00 per annum.

- 5. The City will advance an amount not to exceed \$5,400.00 from the General Fund Unallocated Reserve which will be reimbursed when the District is established.
- 6. 

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
