ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 17202 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON JAN 9 1989

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 22.0101, ENTITLED "PERMANENT RULES OF THE COUNCIL" BY AMENDING RULE 18 RELATING TO THE "COMMITTEE ON RULES, LEGISLATION AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS."

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee, on November 30, 1988, discussed the matter of increasing the membership of the Rules Committee to six (6) members; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney was directed to amend the Permanent Rules of Council, Rule 18, to provide that all Committee chairs plus the Housing Commission chair, plus the Mayor and Deputy Mayor be designated as the six (6) members; and

WHEREAS, it is also necessary to specify in connection therewith that a quorum of said Rules Committee would consist of four (4) members; and

WHEREAS, the Committee approved such action by a 4-1 vote and directed it to be forwarded to the full Council for appropriate action; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 2, Division 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending section 22.0101, Rule 18 to read as follows:


RULE 18. Committee on Rules, Legislation and Intergovernmental Relations

There is a Committee on Rules, Legislation and Intergovernmental Relations (herein referred to as "Rules Committee") composed of six (6) voting members consisting of the Mayor, the Deputy Mayor, the three (3) chairpersons of the other standing committees and the Councilmember appointed as chairperson of the Housing Commission. The Mayor shall be permanent chairperson and the Deputy Mayor shall be vice-chairperson of the Rules Committee. Four (4) of the six (6) members appointed to the Rules Committee shall constitute a quorum to do business but a lesser number may take action to adjourn a meeting.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

Four (4) of the six (6) members appointed to the Rules Committee shall constitute a quorum to do business but a lesser number may take action to adjourn a meeting.
