AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 3, DIVISION 35, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 33.3511 RELATING TO MASSAGE TECHNICIANS WORKING UNDER THE "CONTROL AND DIRECTION" OF EXEMPT CLASS INDIVIDUALS AND RENUMBERING SECTIONS 33.3505 THROUGH 33.3523 EXCEPT FOR SECTIONS 33.3520 THROUGH 33.3522.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 3, Division 35, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 33.3511 to read as follows:

SEC. 33.3511 EXEMPTIONS

This division shall not apply to the following classes of individuals; and no permit shall be required of such persons while engaged in the performance of the duties of their respective professions; nor shall a license be required for the establishment at which a massage is administered by or under the control and direction of such persons.

No changes in subsections (a) through (d).

(e) Holistic health practitioners who are nonmedical health care therapists and use a massage specialty and therapeutic approach in caring for clients and who present to the Chief of Police proof of satisfactory completion of one thousand hours of instruction in such specialty or therapeutic approach at a school with a state approved

curriculum and proof of membership in a state or nationally chartered organization devoted to the specialty or therapeutic approach. The practice of such health care therapists may include other services such as nutritional assistance or counseling as long as all activities are directed toward health care.

- (f) All individuals who use a massage specialty and therapeutic approach in caring for clients while under the "control and direction" of any of the exempted classes of individuals as listed above in sections (a) through (e) must have a valid massage technician permit and comply with all the requirements of section 35.3542.
- (g) For the purpose of this section any individual using massage specialty and therapeutic approach in caring for clients is considered under the "control and direction" of an exempt class individual only when a member of that exempt class is physically present on the establishment premises where the massage is being administered.

Section 2. That Chapter III, Article 3, Division 35, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by renumbering the following sections:

This division shall not apply to the following classes of individuals; and no permit shall be required of such persons while engaged in the performance of the duties of their respective professions; nor shall a license be required for the establishment at which a massage is administered by or under the control and direction of such persons:

No changes in subsections (a) through (d).

- (e) Holistic health practitioners who are nonmedical health care therapists who and use a massage specialty and therapeutic approach in caring for clients and who present to the Chief of Police proof of satisfactory completion of one thousand hours of instruction in such specialty or therapeutic approach at a school with a state **ddfddfdd* approved curriculum and proof of membership in a state or nationally chartered organization devoted to the specialty or therapeutic approach. The practice of such health care therapists may include other services such as nutritional assistance or counseling as long as all activities are directed toward health care.
- (f) All individuals who use a massage specialty and therapeutic approach in caring for clients while under the "control and direction" of any of the exempted classes of individuals as listed above in sections (a) through (e) must

have a valid massage technician permit and comply with all the requirements of section 33.3513.2.

(g) For the purpose of this section any individual using massage specialty and therapeutic approach in caring for clients is considered under the "control and direction" of an exempt class individual only when a member of that exempt class is physically present on the establishment premises where the massage is being administered.

AP ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 3, DIVISION 35, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 33.311 RELATING TO MASSAGE TECHNICOMANS WORKING UNDER THE "CONTROL AND DIRECTION" OF EXEMPT CLASS INDIVIDUALS AND RENUMBERING SECTIONS 33.3505 THROUGH 33.3523 EXCEPT FOR SECTIONS 33.3520 THROUGH 33.3522.

This ordinance amends Chapter III, Article 3, Division 35, section 33,3511 by requiring a massage technician permit for any individual caring for clients while under the "control and direction" of an exempt class individual. It also requires the presence of an exempt class individual to the establishment premises when individuals are using a massage specialty under the "control and direction" of such exempt class individual, Additionally, it changes the instruction requirements of a holistic health practitioner from a state accredited curriculum to a state approved curriculum. Finally, it renumbers Bections 33,3505 through 33,3523 except for Sections 33,3522 inrough 33,3522.
