AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 3, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING SECTION 63.02.34 RELATING TO GRANTING AUTHORITY TO PARK RANGERS TO ENFORCE STATE AND LOCAL CODES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 3, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by adding section 63.02.34 to read as follows:

## SEC. 63.02.34 PARK RANGERS AUTHORIZED TO ENFORCE STATE AND LOCAL CODES - ARRESTS AND CITATIONS

- A. Purpose and Intent. It is the purpose and intent of the Council in enacting this section that all City park rangers be specifically authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 836.5 of the Penal Code of the State of California, to make arrests without a warrant whenever any such park ranger has reasonable cause to believe that the person to be arrested has committed a misdemeanor in the park ranger's presence which is a violation of a statute or ordinance which such park ranger has the duty to enforce.
- B. The park rangers of The City of San Diego, be, and they are hereby authorized, empowered and

given the duty to enforce provisions of the San
Diego Municipal Code and misdemeanors as designated
in the State Codes; to make arrests without a
warrant whenever any such park ranger has
reasonable cause to believe that the person to be
arrested has committed a misdemeanor which it is
his duty to enforce in the park ranger's presence;
and while engaged in the performance of their
duties, to arrest persons and issue citations for
violations of said Codes under the provisions of
Sections 836.5 and 853.6 of the Penal Code of the
State of California when violations occur in City
of San Diego beach or park areas.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
