ADOPTED ON JAN 30 1989

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER IX, ARTICLE 5, DIVISION 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 95.0101 RELATING TO PUBLIC PROPERTY LIMITATIONS BY EXTENDING THE DATE SET FORTH THEREIN FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) MONTHS TO APRIL 30, 1989.

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to extend the time deadline in section 95.0101E.2.a.(5) for a period of three (3) months in order to allow staff and the Executive Committee of the Downtown Marketing Consortium additional time to analyze the continuance of the downtown banners' program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter IX, Article 5, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending section 95.0101 to extend the time deadline set forth therein by amending section 95.0101E.2.a.(5), to read as follows:

SEC. 95.0101 PUBLIC PROPERTY LIMITATIONS


A. through E.2.a.(4) - no changes.

(5) No banners otherwise authorized by this subdivision shall be displayed after April 30, 1989.

Section 2. All other provisions of section 95.0101 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage; provided, however, the time extension contained in section 1 above shall apply upon adoption of this ordinance.
