AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-17098 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89" BY AMENDING EXHIBIT B THERETO TO CREATE AND ADD A NEW CLASS ENTITLED, "SENIOR BIOLOGIST" IN THE CHEMISTS OCCUPATIONAL GROUP; AMENDING EXHIBIT A-2 OF SAID ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE A NEW SALARY RATE NUMBER 80.4 FOR SAID POSITION IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE, AS SET FORTH IN ATTACHMENT A HERETO; AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-270952 TO PLACE THE NEWLY CREATED CLASS IN THE SUPERVISORY REPRESENTATION UNIT; AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-270951 TO APPROVE AND DECLARE THE ABOVE NEWLY CREATED CLASS AS ELIGIBLE FOR REGULAR RATE OVERTIME BY PLACING IT IN GROUP C OF SAID OVERTIME ELIGIBILITY RESOLUTION NO. R-270951.

WHEREAS, the Water Utilities Department has requested the creation of a new Senior Biologist classification to serve as a second-level supervisor over a combined potable water and water reclamation biology laboratory; and

WHEREAS, this request was initiated as the result of a reorganization which consolidated two separate laboratory facilities; and

WHEREAS, as proposed, the Senior Biologist will plan, direct and monitor the work of an Entomologist and subordinate professional and technical staff through a Biologist III; coordinate experiment water reclamation laboratory activities with consultants; serve as the division's liaison with various

issues; design and coordinating special in-house studies associated with water reclamation and potable water production; direct division-wide sampling and laboratory preparation activities; evaluate laboratory data results for compliance with mandated quality and reporting requirements; oversee the training of subordinates; and determine biology lab equipment and staffing needs; and

WHEREAS, the above duties and responsibilities require professional level microbiology, biology and entomology experience and currently, there is no existing classification which encompasses the duties described above or the specialized knowledge, skills and abilities required; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that a new classification of Senior Biologist be created with a salary level equal to Senior Marine Biologist (\$3,079 to \$3,713 per month); and

WHEREAS, it is also recommended that this class be eligible for regular rate overtime under the same conditions as other professional level biologist and chemist classes in the City; and

WHEREAS, these classes are listed in Group C of the Addendum to Personnel Manual Section H-4, Overtime and included in this group are those classes designated as exempt from the overtime provisions of the Fair Labor Standards Act but eligible for regular rate overtime in accordance with City policy; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that this class be placed in the Supervisory Bargaining Unit; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-17098 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Exhibit B thereto by creating and adding a new class, entitled "SENIOR BIOLOGIST" in the Chemists Occupation Group at salary rate number 80.4.

Section 2. That Exhibit A-2 of the above-cited ordinance be amended to include a new salary rate number 80.4, ranging from \$3,079 to \$3,713 per month, at rates and steps as set forth in Attachment A hereto.

Section 3. That Resolution No. R-270952, be and it is hereby amended to place the newly created class of SENIOR BIOLOGIST in the Supervisory Representation Unit.

Section 4. That Resolution No. R-270951, be and it is hereby amended by approving and declaring the newly created class as eligible for regular rate overtime and placing said newly created class in Group C Overtime Eligibility.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

This ordinance amends the annual salary ordinance by amending Exhibit B thereto to create a new class entitled, "SENIOR BIOLOGIST" in the Chemists Occupation Group. It also establishes a rate of pay at Rate 80.4. Finally, the new class is placed in the Supervisory Representation Unit and is declared to be eligible for regular rate overtime.


