AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 8, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 28.01 AND 28.02 RELATING TO POLICE OFFICERS' UNIFORMS, BADGES AND INSIGNIAS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 8, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 28.01 to read as follows:

## SECTION 28.01 POLICE BADGE, PATCH, AND INSIGNIA

That there is hereby established an official badge, patch, and cap insignia for the Police Department of The City of San Diego. Said official badge, patch, and cap insignia shall be of the size, design and materials as set forth in the specifications and drawings on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City under Document

Numbers 254832 (badge and cap insignia) and 00-17264 (patch).

Section 2. That Chapter II, Article 8, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 28.02 to read as follows:

## SECTION 28.02 SAME - OFFICERS' ENTITLED TO WEAR

That the following officers and employees of
The City of San Diego shall be entitled to wear the
official police badge, patch, and cap insignia of
The City of San Diego:

(1) All active officers of the Police Department of The City of San Diego.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
