AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-17122 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. OO-17122-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY ADDING TO THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT (120), FIRE PREVENTION PROGRAM (12030), ONE (1.00) FIRE PREVENTION INSPECTOR II POSITION AND ONE-QUARTER (0.25) CLERICAL ASSISTANT II POSITION, FOR THE HIGH-RISE INSPECTIONS PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, on November 16, 1988, the Public Services and Safety Committee discussed the issue of high-rise building inspection fees (see City Manager Report No. 88-388) which would recover total program costs for state-mandated, high-rise fire and life safety inspections; and

WHEREAS, in connection therewith, the City Manager recommended the establishment of a fee schedule for high-rise building inspections and the addition of 1.25 positions with funding for personnel and non-personnel expenses, said positions to be one (1.00) Fire Prevention Inspector II and one-quarter (0.25) Clerical Assistant II, as more fully set forth in City Manager Report No. 88-260, dated May 13, 1988; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual appropriation ordinance to add to the personnel authorization of the Fire Department (120), Fire Prevention Program (12030) the above specified positions; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-17122 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-17122-1, as amended and adopted therein, by adding to the personnel authorization schedule of the Fire Department (120), Fire Prevention Program (12030) the following new positions for programs as indicated:


HIGH-RISE INSPECTIONS PROGRAM


