- 1. Advise on the acquisition and placement of works of art on property of the City of San Diego, except for any museum, art gallery, or City-owned performance facility. No work of art shall be installed or existing work of art removed from public areas of City property without a review by the Commission.
- 2. Develop and recommend to the Mayor, City Council and City Manager:
- a. Programs to promote public performances and the public exhibition of the arts.
- b. Legislation to provide incentives to the public sector for inclusion of the arts in private developments.

eligible funds will serve as the measurement in checking the amount to be deposited in the Fund for Public Art in accordance with Section 26.0706 of this ordinance.



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 8, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING DIVISION 7; ADDING A DIVISION HEADING; RENUMBERING SECTIONS 28.07, 28.07, 1, 26.07,2, 26.07.3, AND 28.07.4; AMENDING THE HEADING OF NEW SECTION 26.0707; AND, AMENDING THE TEXT OF NEW SECTIONS 28.0703 AND 26.0705

This ordinance amends Subsection C of Section 25.07 by requiring the Commission for Arts, and Culture to make all funding recommendations to a workshop of the Committee of the Whole and then to the Public Services and Safety Committee, rather than taking them directly and exclusively to the full City Council.

This ordinance also contains several housekeeping amendments, including creating a division number and title, renumbering sections 25.07, 26.07.1, 26.07.2, 26.07.3, and 26.07.4, and changing the text to reflect the changes in numbering within the new division.
