AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND AMERICAN NEWLAND ASSOCIATES, HARRY G. COOPER, SORRENTO VALLEY EAST LTD., SAMMIS PROPERTIES, DOUGLAS ALLRED COMPANY, ANDREW W. MCREYNOLDS, CHRISTA MCREYNOLDS, ALBERT P. GRAFF AND MARION R. GRAFF.

WHEREAS, American Newland Associates, Harry G. Cooper,
Sorrento Valley East Ltd., Sammis Properties, Douglas Allred
Company, Andrew W. McReynolds, Christa McReynolds, Albert P.
Graff and Marion R. Graff ("Owner") are the legal or equitable
owners of that certain real property consisting of approximately
557 acres located within the Sorrento Hills community planning
area; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego, a charter city, is authorized pursuant to Government Code Sections 65864 - 65869.5 to enter into binding development agreements with persons having legal or equitable interests in real property for the development of such property in order to establish certainty in the development process. The City further enters into this Development Agreement pursuant to its Charter and self-rule powers and San Diego Municipal Code Sections 105.0101 et seq. and Council Policy No. 600-37; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into this Development
Agreement relating to the above-described real property in
conformance with the provisions of the Government Code in order

to achieve the development of private land uses together with the provision of public services, public uses, and urban infrastructure all in the promotion of the health, safety, and general welfare of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the property is located within the boundaries of the Sorrento Hills community planning area. This community plan was adopted by the Council on March 8, 1983, by Resolution No. R-258074. In conjunction with the adoption of the community plan, the Council certified the information contained in the Environmental Impact Report and approved the findings of the environmental document in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970; and

WHEREAS, development of the subject property will be in conformance with the Sorrento Hills Community Plan, R1-5000, M-IP, M-IB, R-1500, A-1-1 and HRO Zones, Planned Residential Development Permit Nos. 84-0520 and 84-0518, Hillside Review Permit Nos. 183, 83-0167.1, 82-0380, Planned Industrial Development Permit No. 84-0520 and Tentative Map Nos. 84-0520, 84-0519, 86-0573, 88-0102, 83-0167 and 85-0824. The environmental effects of development permitted pursuant to the agreement were addressed in Environmental Impact Report Nos. 85-0824 and 83-0167; Mitigated Negative Declaration Nos. 84-0518, 84-0519 and 84-0520; Environmental Impact Report No. 81-12-33 and Addendums to Environmental Impact Report Nos. 81-12-33, 88-0590, 85-0101 and 82-0380, which has been certified by the City; and

WHEREAS, because of the complexities of financing the urban infrastructure, certainty in the development process is

desirable. The phasing, timing and development of the public infrastructure including, but not limited to, parks, libraries, fire stations, transportation facilities, sewer and water facilities, other utilities, and open space maintenance necessitates a significant commitment of resources, planning and effort by property owners and the City in order for the public facilities financing to be successfully completed. Accordingly, in return for the participation and commitment to provide a pro rata share of public facilities and the significant contribution of private resources for public purposes, the City in return desires to make a commitment for certainty in the development process; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Development Agreement,
Owner will provide substantial public improvements and benefits
to the City including participation in the public facilities
financing plan for the Sorrento Hills Community. In
consideration of the public improvements and benefits to be
provided by Owner pursuant to the Development Agreement, in
consideration of Owner's agreement to finance public facilities,
and in order to strengthen the public planning process and reduce
the economic costs of development, by the Development Agreement
the City intends to give Owner assurance that Owner can proceed
with the development of the subject property for the term of the
Development Agreement pursuant to the Development Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on September 15, 1988, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego, after giving notice pursuant to Government Code Sections 65854, 65854.5, 65856, and Section 105.0103 of the San Diego Municipal Code held a public hearing on the application for the Development Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego, after providing public notice as required by law, held a public hearing on Owner's application, wherein all persons desiring to be heard were heard, and pursuant to said public hearing the Council recommended approval of the Development Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the Development Agreement is consistent with the Progress Guide and General Plan, the Sorrento Hills Community Plan, Council Policy No. 600-37, as well as all other applicable policies and regulations of The City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed and considered the Development Agreement and determined the content of the Development Agreement to be complete and correct; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds and determines the facts stated above to be true.

Section 2. The Council further finds with respect to the Development Agreement that:

A. It is consistent with the objectives, policies, programs and uses specified in the Progress Guide and General Plan, the Sorrento Hills Community Plan, and Council Policy No. 600-37.

B. It will not be detrimental to the public health, safety and general welfare.

C. It will promote the orderly development of property or the preservation of property values in accordance with good land use practice.

Section 3. The Council hereby approves the Sorrento Hills Development Agreement, Case No. 88-0590, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No.

execute said Development Agreement in the name of The City of San Diego not later than 15 days following the effective date of this ordinance. Failure of Owner to execute the Development Agreement within 30 days, shall render this action null and void. The City Clerk is directed to record said Development Agreement and this ordinance with the County Recorder of San Diego County within ten days after its execution.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
