AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-17122 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. OO-17122-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY AMENDING THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS DEPARTMENT (015) BY AUTHORIZING ONE (1.00) NEW COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE II POSITION; DELETING ONE (1.00) INTERMEDIATE STENOGRAPHER POSITION; EXEMPTING THE NEWLY AUTHORIZED COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE II POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE, AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the Mayor's office desires to convert one (1.00) Intermediate Stenographer position, presently authorized in the Intergovernmental Relations Department, and substitute in lieu thereof, one (1.00) Council Representative II position to its personnel allocation; and

WHEREAS, it has also been requested that the newly authorized Council Representative position be exempted from the Classified Service and placed in the Unclassified Service; and

WHEREAS, section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs" may be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance upon first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission reviewed this request on May 10, 1989 and has commented favorably upon the exemption as meeting the criteria set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual appropriation ordinance to effectuate said reclassification; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-17122 (NEW SERIES), as amended entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1988-89 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-17122-1, as adopted and amended therein, by amending the personnel authorization schedule for the Intergovernmental Relations Department (015) to authorize the addition of one Council Representative II position and to delete, in lieu thereof, one (1.00) Intermediate Stenographer position.


Section 2. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission in its memorandum to the City Council, dated May 11, 1989, attached hereto as Attachment A, the Council Representative II position authorized in section 1 above is hereby exempted from the Classified Service and declared to be in the Unclassified Service of The City of San Diego.

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the above unclassified position created in sections 1 and 2 hereof, the

salary rate set forth in Salary Rates 7.0, 7.1 and 7.2 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Managerial Category A, contained in Exhibit C to Ordinance No. O-17098 (NEW SERIES), be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage after two (2) public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.

SUBJECT: Exemption of Council Representative Position from the
Classified Service

On May 10, 1989, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Mayor's Office to exempt a Council Representative position from the Classified Service.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "Managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council."

Upon review of the duties and responsibilities to be performed, the Commission finds that this position meets the criteria of the Charter and supports exemption from the Classified Service. If additional information would be of assistance in your consideration of this matter, staff is available to respond with details as necessary.
